

**ALAN NEUFELD NAMED ON *TOP LAWYERS LIST*
BY *SOUTH FLORIDA LEGAL GUIDE***

The *South Florida Legal Guide* 2005 Annual Edition has recognized Alan S. Neufeld, founding partner of Neufeld, Kleinberg & Pinkiert, as one of the top lawyers in the practice area of litigation in South Florida.

The South Florida Top Lawyers List compiled annually by the Legal Guide is considered to be the definitive list of “lawyers’ lawyers” in the region. Opinions are drawn from highly regarded attorneys based on criteria set forth by the publication.

Neufeld, Kleinberg & Pinkiert (NKP), located in Aventura, is a plaintiffs’ law firm representing individuals that have been the victims of accidents, injuries, and negligence. Neufeld has been representing seriously-injured clients for over 30 years. A native of New York, he graduated with honors in finance from Syracuse University and went on to earn his Juris Doctorate from the University of Miami School of Law in 1975. Alan has tried cases in both Federal District Court and State Circuit Courts, setting two records for the highest awards in personal injury cases in Florida history.

In a high-profile auto negligence case, Neufeld was co-counsel with David Kleinberg in *Edwin Mejia and Nelly Mejia v. Manheim Auctions Government Services*. They won the largest verdict in state history for an automobile accident case, resulting in a \$23.5 million damage award.

Neufeld was the lead counsel in *Riles v. Bonaventure Golf Course, et al*, a case that resulted in the highest jury verdict ever recorded in the U.S. against a golf course, for a lawsuit involving defective design. Mr. Riles was blinded in one eye by a golf ball while working as a general contractor on a house, when the ball ricocheted off a wall and hit him. The jury rendered a verdict against the country club for over \$2.9 million, later upheld by the 4th District Court of Appeals in the amount of \$3.3 million, including interest.

Neufeld, Kleinberg & Pinkiert represents plaintiffs in individual lawsuits, involving automobile accidents, defective product, medical malpractice, and slip and fall. The firm is comprised of five highly experienced practice members, each of whom brings persuasive talents and remarkable skills to the table.

Alan is an active member of the Aventura Marketing Council. He is on the Board of Governors for the North Dade Bar Association and is currently the president of the Citizens Advisory Committee for the Metro 6 Intracoastal Police Department. He is also a member of the North Miami Beach Optimist Club for which he volunteers his time organizing the annual Special Olympics. In addition, he runs a Moot Court demonstration for local high school students contemplating the legal profession.
